- 1. Situation. This Operation Order is a standing order for the guidance of DAVIDSON Shellbacks and is in support of references (a), (b) and (c). The general situation is as set forth in reference (a).

- c. Conduct a vigorous program to ensure that all pollywogs are duly informed of their subjugation to all Sons of Neptune and continue such exercises as required to maintain the pollywogs at the highest level of such subjugation and preparation for their initiation as Sons of Neptune.
- 4. Administration and Logistics.
  - a. Logistics normal or as directed.
- b. Administrative responsibilities are contained in reference (b), Neptunus Rex SOP.

# 5. Communications and Flags.

- a. Communications and flags will be in accordance with Annex F to this OPORD.
- b. Succession to the Throne is in accordance with reference (c).
- c. USS DAVIDSON is assigned Flagship while His Royal Majesty is embarked.
- 6. Acknowledgement of this Instruction. All Sons of Neptune Aboard DAVIDSON will acknowledge this Operation Order by appearing at such designated places as directed by His Royal Highness and ensuring that all pollywogs under their respective control appear when and where directed.

#### ANNEX A

#### CONCEPT

# THE ANCIENT TRADITION OF BECOMING A SHELLBACK

1. General. The boisterous ceremonies of "Crossing the Line" are of such ancient vintage that their derivation is lost. It is well known that ceremonies took place long ago when the ship crossed the thirtieth parallel and also when going through the Straits of Gibraltar. These early ceremonies were of the roughest sort and were, to a great extent, supposed to try the crew to determine whether or not the novices on their first cruise would endure the hardships of a life at sea. Then, as in the custom of the present time, it was primarily a crew's party.

Neptunus Rex, the mythological god of the seas, was appeased by the seaman, and marks of respect were paid those of his underwater domain. It is plausible that a part of the ceremony grew out of tradition of the times gone past, even though sailors had come to doubt the existence of Neptune. Nevertheless, Neptunus Rex is today the majesty that rules the ceremonies.

Those who have crossed the line are called "Shellbacks"; these Sons of Neptune compose the cast for the present day ceremonies. It is a curious fact of human nature that "pollywogs" suffer an uncomfortable initiation in order to become "Shellbacks".

The crossing the line ceremonies of today's modern Navy have retained much of the traditional discomforts of old and are certainly picturesque. Although the physical discomforts are not severe, the inflictions usually affect only one's pride. Those who survive the initiation become "Shellbacks", the Sons of Neptune.

The eldest and most dignified of the Shellbacks in the crew is usually selected as Neptunus Rex, his first assistant is Davey Jones. Her Highness Amphitrite is usually one who will appear well in deshabille of seaweed and rope yarns with her face made up so as to appear very alluring. The court consists of the Royal Scribe, the Royal Dentist, Royal Doctor and Royal Prosecutor plus any others that suit the fancy of the Royal Party. The Bears also have a difficult task or rounding up the uninitiated and also dousing watches in the canvas water tank.

The fattest Shellback is dressed in a diaper and is designated as the Royal Baby. All pollywogs are required to pay homage to the Royal Baby by kissing his belly.

The night before the ship crosses the line, it is the custom that Davey Jones shall appear onboard with a message to the Captain from His majesty, Neptunus Rex, stating at what time he wants the ship hove to for reception of the Royal Party, and with summons for the pollywogs to appear before the Royal Court for trial.

# DIALOGUE BETWEEN BRIDGE AND ROYAL PARTY

1. General. The following dialogue between Davey Jones and the Bridge will be followed:

Pipe all hands and announce over the IMC: 1600 BMOW "Officer of the Deck, the lookouts have reported the arrival of Davey Jones and party through the Bull Nose and they are now on the fo'c'sle". Immediately after passing that word, sound seven boat gongs and pass the word "Davey Jones, Arriving." 1605 DAVEY "Officer of the Deck, I am Davey Jones, messenger to His Royal Majesty, Neptunus Rex, Ruler of the Raging Main, and I demand to know what this ship is, what course you are steering and by whose authority you dare trespass within our Royal Domain." OOD "This is the USS DAVIDSON (FF-1045), steering course True." "Notify your Commanding Officer that I, DAVEY Davey Jones, have a message to deliver to him from His Royal Majesty, Neptunus Rex." "Davey, the Captain awaits your arrival OOD on the starboard quarterdeck. Chief Master at Arms, report to Davey Jones on the starboard bridge wing and escort him to the Commanding Officer on the starboard quarterdeck." 1615

Davey Jones and entourage depart for the starboard quarterdeck escorted by the CMAA. The Royal Party will proceed aft along the starboard side.

# DIALOGUE BETWEEN CAPTAIN AND DAVEY JONES

1. General. The following dialogue between Davey Jones and the Commanding Officer commencing at approximately 1615, 06 Jun 80 on the starboard quarterdeck (using the 1MC):

CAPTAIN

"Greetings, Davey Jones. Welcome Aboard."

DAVEY

"Greetings to you, Captain. On behalf of my
Royal Master, I extend to you a most cordial
welcome to the Realm of Neptune. I have been
commissioned by the Ruler of the Raging Main,
Neptunus Rex himself, to deliver a letter to
you, which he requests you read to your command."

CAPTAIN

Reads the letter:

From: His Royal Majesty, Neptunus Rex To: Commanding Officer, USS DAVIDSON (FF-1045)

- 1. Greetings. It has been brought to my attention through my Trusty Shellbacks, that a strange ship, USS DAVIDSON, manned by many pollywogs who have not yet acknowledged the sovereignty of my Domain intends to pass through it. This fact incurs my Royal Displeasure.
- 2. Be it known that I, Neptunus Rex, Supreme Ruler of all Mermaids, sharks, squid, crabs, whales and Denizens of the Deep, with my Royal Court will meet in full session onboard your offending vessel on the morrow to examine the fitness of all of your landlubbers to be taken into the Realm of the Deep and to hear their pitifull defenses on the various and sundry charges that have been placed against them.

"Davey; tell your Royal Master, Neptunus Rex, that I would be honored to receive him and his Royal Party onboard at any time."

DAVEY

"My Master thanks you, Captain, and we of the Great Neptunus Court bring serious indictments against those members of your crew who still have traces of heifer dust and cow dung on their feet, as well of those of the big towns who think they are real city slickers. But no matter, all will be Shellbacks after the rough treatment and final judgement tomorrow when all will be summoned to appear before the Royal Judge of His August Majesty, Neptunus Rex, and will answer for their offenses committed both aboard and ashore. Have all of your slimy pollywogs prepare themselves for the terrible doom that awaits them on the morrow."

CAPTAIN

"Aye, and thank you Davey, we will heed your warning and prepare a Royal Welcome for His Majesty. In the meantime, we have gathered up the finest young virgin maidens onboard to participate in a Beauty Contest to select the finest virgin as a gift to King Neptune. It would be a great honor if you and your retinue would stay for the contest and assist me in selecting the most fitting of the fair maidens present as fitting gift for King Neptune."

# ARRIVAL OF NEPTUNUS REX

# INITIATION PLAN AND DIVISIONAL PARADE

- 1. General. When the ship is ready in all respects and the crew mustered in divisional berthing compartments, the reception of King Neptune and Party will commence at 1000 on 07 Jun 80. The Royal Navigator reports that the ship will cross the line at 0945 on 07 June over the IMC system. The following sequence of events will take place:
- a. Davey Jones will appear at the Bull Nose on the fo'c'sle. BMOW sound 7 boat gongs and announce "DAVEY JONES, ARRIVING." Davey proceeds to the starboard bridge wing and into the pilot house and announces over the 1MC"

"Officer of the Deck, The Captain is to be informed that King Neptune and his Royal Court have been sighted ahead."

- b. The Officer of the Deck (when directed by Davey Jones at approximately 1000) has the following word passed:
- 10 boat gongs, then "Raging Main, Arriving, Attention on Deck, Signalman, break the Jolly Roger."
- c. Immediately after the word "Raging Main, Arriving" is passed, King Neptune and the Royal Party appear on the fo'c'sle from the Bull Nose and proceed to the bridge (up the starboard side) to greet Davey Jones. The dialogue set forth in Appendix 1 to this Annex takes place between King Neptune, Davey Jones and the Captain over the 1MC system.
- d. Shellbacks in the route of King Neptune from the fo'c'sle to the bridge will ensure that the route is kept clear and that proper honors are rendered.
- e. Immediately on completion of the dialogue, King Neptune and the Royal Party proceed to the fantail.
- 2. Division Quarters. Quarters for muster of all pollywogs will be conducted in divisional berthing compartments at 0930 on 03 Jun 80. Muster reports will be submitted to King Neptune on the fantail by the senior pollywog in each division.

# 3. Commencement and Conduct of the Ceremony.

- a. The initiation will commence when decreed by Neptunus Rex and the commencement will be announced by the Trusty Announcer on the Bridge.
- b. Divisions will be called away as directed over the 1MC by the Trusty 1MC Announcer.
- c. On completion of the divisional muster in the berthing compartments, pollywogs may appear topside on the port side of main deck and on the fo'c'sle only. Trusty Shellbacks will ensure that pollywogs do not stray into unauthorized areas. Royal Turtles will move the pollywogs into the formation as divisions are called away.
- 4. Equipment. Initiation equipment will be located on the fantail.
- 5. Royal Party. The Royal Party shall be located on the fantail and will be positioned in such a manner to be conducive to good photography.
- 6. Conclusion of Ceremony. The ceremony will be concluded when the last pollywog has been properly initiated.
- a. On conclusion of the ceremony, King Neptune and Party will depart.
- b. BMOW, when directed by Davey Jones, sound 10 boat gongs and announce (via 1MC): "RAGING MAIN, DEPARTING." The signal-man then hauls down the Jolly Roger.

1. General: King Neptune and the Royal Party arrive onboard at about 1000 on 07 Jun 80 and proceed to the bridge where Davey Jones and the Captain are waiting. The following dialogue ensues over the 1MC:

KING NEPTUNE "Greetings, Davey Jones. Well, well, a proud ship she is, but sorely and well infested with slimy pollywogs."

DAVEY JONES

"Aye, that she is, Your Majesty. Your
Royal Highness, this is the United States
Ship DAVIDSON, far from her home waters,
and I would like for you to meet her
Captain."

CAPTAIN "A sailors welcome to you, King Neptune.

It is a great pleasure to have you onboard."

KING NEPTUNE

"The pleasure is mine, Captain. Your ship is sorely infested with nefarious and slimy pollywogs, a situation which my Royal Party intends to correct by making them fit for the Raging Main."

# UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

- 1. General. This ANNEX is promulgated to prescribe appropriate uniforms of the day for all Shellbacks and pollywogs for the period 06-07 Jun 80. The following uniforms will be worn by all concerned:
  - a. All pollywogs:
    - (1) Long khaki or dungaree trousers worn backwards and inside out with undershirt. Skivvy shorts must be worn backwards outside the trousers.
    - (2) Appropriate footwear (no sandles or shower shoes).
    - (3) Left leg shaved from kneecap to ankle.
    - (4) Left pants leg rolled up to above knee.
  - b. All Trusty Shellbacks:
    - (1) Appropriate costume as designed by the individual.

# WATCHES AND SPECIAL DETAILS

# 1. General.

- a. Watches and Instructions.
- (1) Watches will be set from 1330 to 1530 on 06 Jun 80 and from 0800 to 1000 on 07 Jun 80 unless modified by the Officer of the Deck as directed by Davey Jones. The watch will be properly relieved at designated intervals by those that are determined to be more fit to stand the watch.
- (2) Each watchstander will, prior to assuming the watch, shift into the required uniform for that watch as outlined in this Annex. Upon completion of each watch, relieved watchstanders will shift into the Uniform of the Day as prescribed in the Plan of the Day.
- (3) No nonsense or skylarking by pollywogs will be tolerated while standing watches assigned under this Annex.
- (4) All watches will be prepared to explain their duties and the importance of their watch to any "Trusty Shellback" that happens by upon request.
- (5) It will be the responsibility of each pollywog to obtain the materials required for his watch, with the exception of those items so specified and designated by Trusty Shellbacks.
- (6) All watches will be stationed promptly when set in a smart and military fashion, as set forth in Appendix 1 of this Annex. Instructions must be carried out promptly and with vigor.
- (7) All pollywogs will be required to carry out any and all instructions given to them by any Son of Neptune.
- (8) The Special OOD, assisted by his staff of special watchstanders and all loyal and Trusty Shellbacks on the ship will be responsible for mustering, stationing and instructing all of the Special Equatorial Details required, ensuring that the pollywogs assigned carry out their prescribed duties.
- (9) New Shellbacks shall relieve Trusty Old Senior Shellbacks on watch stations on the bridge and below decks in a timely manner so that all may participate in the festivities.

- b. Special Details.
- (1) Special Details will be performed as prescribed in Appendices I through 3 of this Annex.

# SUPPLEMENT TO DAVIDSON OPORD 1-80

Subj: USS DAVIDSON Crossing the Line Ceremony; Supplement to

Ref: (a) DAVIDSON OPORD 1-80 of May 80

- 1. Purpose. The purpose of the supplement is to provide specific guidance and assign additional responsibilities not defined in reference (a) for the timely and efficient initiation of DAVIDSON pollywogs into the Ancient Order of the Deep. This supplement will include:
  - a. Safety precautions for Crossing the Line.
- b. Rules and regulations governing the conduct during pollywog day and initiation day.
  - c. The intinerary.
  - d. Duties and responsibilities.
  - e. pollywog uniform of the day.
  - f. Menu of the day.
  - g. pollywog parade route.
  - h. Administration and processing of pollywogs.
  - i. Batting order of the divisions

# 2. Safety precautions.

- a. No pollywog will wear contact lenses.
- b. Nothing will be in any pollywog's pocket.
- c. Shillelaghs will be made of fire hose material only and they will be no longer than two feet in length and there shall be no weights or metal in them.
- d. No individual will stand closer than one foot to the lifelines.
- e. No wog will be branded, hit or hung by a Shellback above the shoulders.
- f. No one will be hit hard enough to break any bones or inflict skin abrasions or contusions.

- g. Nothing will be placed in the wog's eyes what-so-ever. Only authorized garbage and grease will be used by the Royal Barbers, Royal Dentist and Royal Doctor.
  - h. There will be no running whatsoever by anyone at anytime.
  - i. No one will be hung over the side for any reason.
- j. All firehoses will be in the FOG position only. No straight stream will be used for any purpose other than to clean up afterwards and then only after all personnel have cleared the area.
- k. Nothing will be placed in any wog's mouth so that he could possibly swallow it.
- 1. No water or garbage or anything that will make the ship dirty or dangerous to personnel will be allowed inside the skin of the ship.
- m. No individual shall be physically forced to participate in the ceremony.
- n. Fighting, wrestling and other forms of hostile physical contact are strictly forbidden.
- o. No wog will show any retaliation towards a Shellback or severe disciplinary action by the Royal Prosecutor will be taken.
- 3. Rules and Regulations for Crossing the Line.
  - No haircutting (left leg permitted).
- b. No new Shellbacks will participate in the ceremony after being initiated.
- c. All picture taking will be accomplished from the top of the helo hangar only.
- d. New Shellbacks are to clear the initiation area expeditiously upon completion of their initiation.
- e. Condition ZEBRA will be set and maintained on the main deck until the ceremony is completed. New Shellbacks will enter the ship on the portside only through the door just forward of the helo hangar (for those living aft) and through the door nearest ASROC Post I (for those living forward) and proceed expeditiously to their respective showerrooms.
- f. All pollywog skylarking will cease at the start of the pollywog Beauty contest which will be held at 1615 on 06 Jun 80.

- g. No pollywog will be hit on any part of his body other than the RUMP.
- h. Any pollywog who chooses not to go through the initiation will not be permitted to view, take part in or photograph the ceremony in any manner. He will be taken below decks and remain their standing whatever watch he is qualified for and is assigned to by King Neptune, and further, upon completion of the ceremony, he will remain a slimy pollywog and his service record will so reflect. There will be no entry whatsoever made of this individual crossing the line in his service record.

### 4. Itinerary.

- a. On 06 Jun 80, pollywog watches will be stood from 1330-1530. Watches will be as assigned by the Shellback Senior Watch Officer and Senior Division Sons of Neptune.
- b. DAVIDSON will cross the line on 07 Jun 80 while enroute Diego Garcia. The schedule of events is as follows:

0500: Reveille.

0530: Muster all pollywogs at foul weather parade

for last rites.

0600-0700 Breakfast for pollywogs.

0700: Breakfast for Shellbacks.

0800: Set Special pollywog watches as directed

by the pollywog duty list and division Shellbacks.

0930: Muster all pollywogs on portside, main deck.

0930: Station Trusty Shellbacks for Davey Jones arrival.

0945: Davey Jones arrives.

1000: Arrival of King Neptune.

1010: Commence the day of Judgement.

1500: Complete day of Judgement, clean up the ship.

1600-1830: Cookout on the fantail.

Note: The noon meal will be served from 1215 to 1400.

### 5. pollywog uniform of the day.


- a. Dungarees of khakis on inside out and worn backwards, skivvys on backwards worn outside of trousers, left pants leg rolled up.
  - b. Shower shoes taped to the knees securely (optional).
- c. Tennis shoes or other authorized footwear (no sandals or shower shoes).
  - d. Left leg shaved from kneecap to ankle (traditional).
- e. Maximum of three times through the line allowed. Only the Royal Court can send a man back through the line with the recommendation of any Shellback.

### pollywog duties.

- a. Submit yourself to King Neptune's Court.
- b. Obey all orders issued by any Trusty Shellback.
- c. Adhere to pollywog uniform regulations.
- d. Keep a sense of humor.

### pollywog parade route.

- a. The parade route is shown in figure #1.
- b. As individual divisions are called away, assemble at the starboard break heading aft. The Trusty Shellback will call the order and wogs shall remain in that order to insure that summons issued are presented in the right order to the Royal Scribe.
- c. When wogs pass through the starboard break they will assume the lowly wog position, the proper position of reverence and respect for his majesty (crawling on hands and knees, hailing Davey Jones).
- d. From the starboard break wogs will crawl along the route indicated in figure #1, submitting himself to all punishment rendered by the Royal Court.
- e. Upon emerging from the Royal Swimming Pool, he will give his name to the Royal Scribe stationed by the pool and proceed to the Royal Saltwater Showers rigged on the port side forward of the helo hangar extension.
- f. Upon completion of showering, the new Shellback will strike below via the main deck hatches previously described.

g. New Shellbacks are not to take part in the initiation ceremony but may view the ceremonies from the top of the helo hangar.

when that division is called away over the 1MC system.


